# GUIDELINES FOR THE CONTEST

Along with your art entry, you must include; this form marking each item with an “X” in each space ☐ accepting each of the contest’s guidelines and your participation form (pages 2 and 3).

- ☐ The art must be based on the conference theme “The Role of the Community Promotor in Creating Equity and a Culture of Prevention”
- ☐ The participation is free, and the technique to use is open.
- ☐ In order to participate your entry must be sent before **AUGUST 1, 2022**.
- ☐ The art entry must be sent digitally by email.
- ☐ Digital images/photos must be of high resolution (a minimum of 300 dpi).
- ☐ The art entry must include Visión y Compromiso’s logo in its original colors.
- ☐ The art entry must be original/never published.
- ☐ Each participant may present as many designs as he/she considers opportune.
- ☐ The participants freely grant the rights of the art entry to Visión y Compromiso to be used at its discretion. This applies to the selected art entry and to the designs submitted for the contest, even if they were not selected.
- ☐ The contest is open to all promotores and community health workers as well as the people close to them (family members, friends, and acquaintances). If the person participating is not a promotor/a or community worker, he or she must have been referred by one.
- ☐ The winning art entry will be selected by a committee of judges made up from the conference’s planning committee, the staff from Visión y Compromiso, and especial invitees with knowledge in the areas of art and design.
- ☐ Visión y Compromiso and the conference’s organizing committee will not be responsible for lost or damaged materials, or materials sent to an incorrect address or person.
- ☐ The author of the selected art entry will receive a prize of \$300.
- ☐ The author of the art entry will not be able to reproduce the design for commercial use without Visión y Compromiso’s authorization.
