WORKSHOP FORMAT AND REQUIREMENTS

THE WORKSHOP MUST:

- ✓ Be presented entirely in Spanish, with the exception of workshops specifically geared toward youth or administrators.
- ✓ Present the topic in a creative manner.
- ✓ Be 90 minutes (1.5 hours) long. This time allotment must include:
 - A welcome and introduction of the facilitator, conducted by the workshop moderator (5 minutes).
 - Presentation of content using interactive or experiential methodologies designed for adults. A maximum of 80 minutes is allotted for this section; this 80-minute period must include time for questions and answers.
 - 5 minutes for participants to complete the workshop evaluation form provided by Visión y Compromiso.
- ✓ Along with your proposal, the materials you plan to use during your workshop must be submitted in digital format (PowerPoint presentations, handouts, additional resources). These materials will be shared with all participants by email at the conclusion of the conference.
- ✓ You may submit more than one proposal, provided that you complete a separate submission form for each proposal.

A PROPOSAL WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- ✗ If it promotes a product or service that entails a cost. Such items should be presented only as part of a comprehensive list of resources provided to the participant.
- ✗ If the proposal is incomplete or is submitted after the established deadline.

REGISTRATION AND FEES FOR FACILITATORS

Visión y Compromiso does not offer an honorarium to the facilitator(s) for their presentation at the conference. If your workshop is selected, you will be responsible for your own travel and accommodation expenses. However, you will not be required to pay the participation fee on the day of your workshop. All proposals will be reviewed and selected based on the following criteria:

- ❑ The proposal includes one of the themes and workshop types described above and indicates the content/skill level.
- ❑ The workshop content is relevant to promotoras and CHWs.
- ❑ The workshop's goal and objectives are clear and consistent.
- ❑ The presentation process, content, and timing are consistent with the workshop's objectives and description.
- ❑ The proposal presents creative and practical ideas and approaches to the topic, utilizing interactive methodologies.
- ❑ The workshop content integrates a holistic perspective on the topic.
- ❑ The proposal includes practical experiences, bibliographic references, and evidence based on research studies.
- ❑ The workshop has been previously presented to promotoras and CHWs successfully.
